

Homework Schedule

Year 1

Thursdays – 2 pieces of work (1 Maths, 1 topic or literacy based) - both due in by the following Thursday.
Ongoing – phonics (sounds) and handwriting practice.
Reading at home – expected to read daily for 5 minutes minimum to/with an adult and noted in reading diary.

Year 2

Friday – English, Maths and spellings to learn will all be sent home on Friday -due in the following Friday.
New spellings will be given when children are confident at spelling all words on their list.
Reading at home – expected at least 3 times a week and noted in reading diary. Books sent home are not intended to challenge but to reinforce key skills. Please make a note of your child’s reading in their reading journal.

Year 3

Literacy and Numeracy (one piece of each) given out on a Monday – to be in the following Monday.
Approximately 30 minutes for each piece.
Occasional – Science and History homework activities.
Daily 5 minutes times table practice and 5 minutes spelling practice. Spellings test each Monday.

Year 4

All homework set on Friday and due in the following Friday.

- Each week learning spellings in SACAWAC book – say and cover and write and check – practise four times.
- Each week Maths work, usually practising what has been learnt that week in class.
- Either some English grammar or punctuation work or some topic-related work, possibly research or project work.
- Reading at home at least three times a week. Please record in Reading Record.

Year 5

One piece of Maths homework given on Friday.
One piece of English homework given on Friday.
Some children will be given particular spellings to learn at home and/or handwriting to practise.
Children expected to read regularly at home.
All homework to be given in by the following Thursday. (Children will be expected to go to Homework Club on Thursday lunchtime to complete any homework not done at home).

Year 6

Monday	Spellings to learn for following Monday.
	Literacy homework due in the following Monday.
Thursday	Science homework } due in the
Friday	Maths homework } following Tuesday.

Year 6 homework, apart from spellings should be about 30-40 minutes for each piece. Approximately 2 hours per week.

Reading – we still expect the Year 6 children to be reading a variety of books and other reading material at home.
